This is hereby notified that one post of Administrative Member in the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal in the scale of pay of Rs.75,500-80,000/- plus other allowances as admissible as per Rules(Vide this Department Order No. 972-Estt. Dated 10.02.09) is likely to be filled up shortly.

2. In terms of Section 4 (3) (c) of the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal Act,1997, as amended subsequently, no person shall be qualified for appointment as an Administrative Member unless he is or has been,

- i) The West Bengal Land Reforms Act, 1955
- ii) The West Bengal Estate Acquisition Act, 1953
- iii) The West Bengal Acquisition of Homestead Land for Agricultural Labourers, Artisans & Fishermen Act, 1975
- iv) The West Bengal Restoration of Alienated Land Act, 1973
- v) The West Bengal Premises Tenancy Act, 1997
- vi) The West Bengal Thika Tenancy (Acquisition & Regulation) Act, 2001

(a) an officer of the Central Government, not below the rank of a Joint Secretary to that Government, and has dealt with matters under the specified Acts during his service under the State Government for a period of not less than three years or (b) an officer of the State Government, not below the rank of a Joint Secretary to that Government, and has dealt with matters under the specified Acts during his service under the State Government for a period of not less than five years. The list of specified Acts is noted in the margin.

3. The service conditions for the post of Administrative Member have been detailed in the Notification No.3185-L.Ref./1A-05/2002 dated 24.10.2002 as amended subsequently, vide this Department's Notification No. 1674-Estt. Dated 10.03.08.

4. In terms of rule 6 of the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal (Salaries, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of the Chairman and other Members) Rules, 2002, the Chairman or any other Member who, on the date of his appointment to the Tribunal, was in service under the Central Government or the State Government, shall seek retirement from such service before his appointment to the Tribunal.

5. Applications are therefore invited from amongst the willing persons who fulfill the above conditions for selection to the post of Administrative Member of the West Bengal Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal in the format annexed hereto. Applications may be sent in sealed envelopes superscribed " Application for the post of Administrative Member in the West Bengal Land Reforms & Tenancy Tribunal" .

The application is to be sent to the Land Reforms Commissioner and Additional Chief Secretary, Land and Land Reforms Department, Writers' Buildings, Kolkata-1 in quadruplicate positively by 15.11.2013. Further to mention that selection will be made by a Committee headed by a Sitting Judge of Calcutta High Court to be nominated by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court, Calcutta.
