Sub. Disposal of conversion cases.

It has come to the notice of the Directorate that petitioners while submitting conversion petitions, either at the office of the DL&LRO/SDL&LRO/BL&LRO, are never informed of their date of hearing or date of field enquiry. Sometimes it is also alleged that such petitioners are waiting for a call from the field level functionaries for months together. This practice undoubtedly results in lack of transparency which is ultimately giving a bad name to our Department.

Hence in order to bring better transparency in service, you are requested to please ensure that the petitioners for conversion get the date of first hearing on the date of submitting the application itself and to instruct the inspecting official to submit the enquiry report positively before the date of such hearing.

It may also be noted that conversion cases should be disposed through e-Bhuchitra application only.
